**The Gallery has established annual scholarships for College students who are pursuing studies that support our mission statement above. Deadline is July 1, 2022.**

The requirements of the scholarship are as follows:

- Students must be accepted into a College program (either undergraduate or graduate) and pursuing studies that would support working for peace and justice.
- The recipient may use the scholarship funds for tuition and other costs incurred in attending a college or university.
- This is a one-year scholarship. However, a recipient who is not on academic probation and is making satisfactory progress toward completion of a degree may reapply for scholarship renewal. However, priority will be given to new applicants. The student is required to submit a completed application for each year the scholarship is requested.
